

I am very pleased and excited to announce our residential visit to London next March.

We will travel to London by train on the Monday morning and will use the underground during our visit. It will be a very busy 4 days and our activities will include:

- Lion King Musical
- London Eye
- River boat cruise along the Thames
- London Aquarium
- Covent Garden market and a meal in Covent garden one evening
- A tour of the Houses of Parliament and a workshop
- Natural History Museum or Science Museum
- Tower of London
- A look at various other sights to include Buckingham Palace, the Mall, St James' Park, Westminster Abbey and any others we can fit in during our time there!

As well as the above activities, also included in the cost is:

- Three nights' accommodation which includes cooked breakfast each morning
- Two evening meals on the Lord Amory and one in Covent Garden
- Lunch on the Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday
- Travel to and around London
- A snack and drink for the train journey home on the Thursday

The cost of the trip will be £240 which includes board, lodgings, travel and activities. I am sure you will agree this is excellent value for money for 4 days in London. The school will be subsidising a substantial amount towards the visit. The only additional money your child will need during the trip will be any spending money for souvenirs if you so wish.
