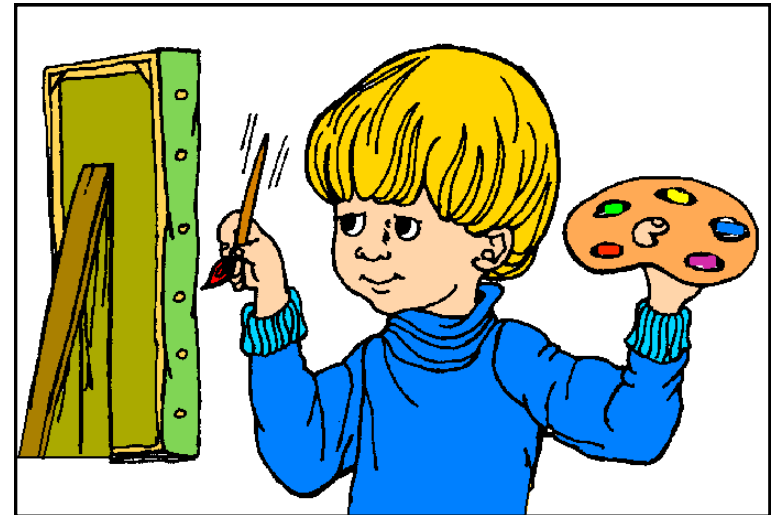


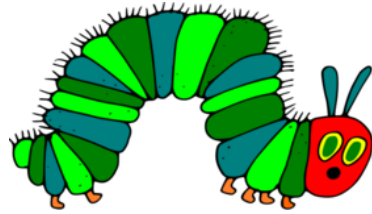
Foundation Stage

throughout the week accordingly.

### Communication and Language

- Listening to stories and poems about animals such as The Very Hungry Caterpillar
- Sharing own knowledge of animals
- Role play in the pet shop



### Reading and Writing

- Reading stories about animals
- Creating a leaflet about caring for animals
- Researching facts and writing a fact file
- Creating posters for role play pet shop



### Problem Solving, Reasoning and Numeracy

- Recording favourite animals
- Talking about data and answering questions
- Identifying and using coins in the role play

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Supporting new children
- Being role models and promoting the golden rules
- Being part of a team on sports day
- Being healthy and keeping pets healthy
- Caring for animals

- Sorting animals into groups
- Learning about what animals eat
