Early Years Foundation Stage

100% of our Reception children achieved a **‘Good Level of Development’** compared to a National average of **66%** and a Cornwall average of **63%**. The school’s average score was **35.1** compared to a national average of **34.4** and a Cornwall average of **34.7**

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

At the end of Year 1 children complete a phonics check; this is to check the children’s understanding of phonics (reading).
