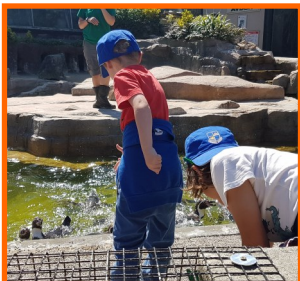
Warm weather reminders
