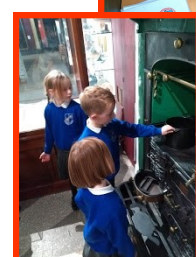
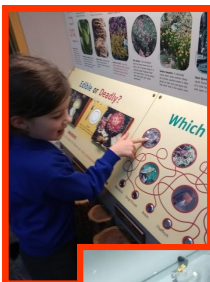


Rotten Romans and

Truro Museum

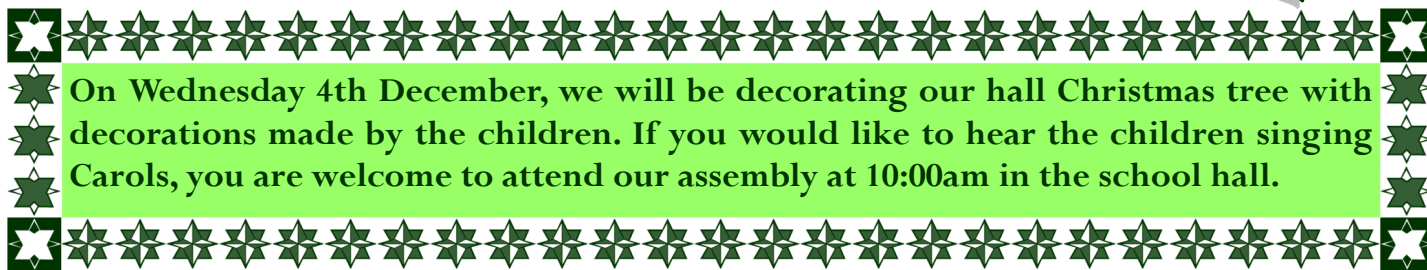
