Sports Day

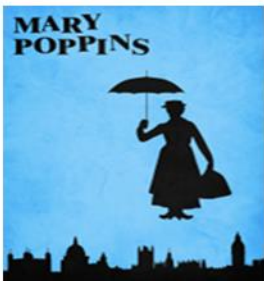
